Church House Farm Privacy Policy

We would like to assure you that we are committed to protecting the privacy of all our guests. We will ensure that the information you provide us with is kept private and confidential, and we will only use it to provide the services you request.

Information you voluntarily provide

When you complete a booking, send us an email, or communicate with us in any way you are voluntarily giving us information that we collect. That information may include your name, address, email address, phone number, credit card information, as well as other demographic information. By giving us this information, you consent to this information being collected, used, and stored, as described in this privacy policy. In the interest of your privacy, we only collect, use and retain information reasonably required for our legitimate business interests, such as processing bookings and queries.

Information we automatically collect

When you browse the website or make a booking, we may automatically collect information about your visit by using cookies. This information may include your device type, browser, IP address, how you came to the website or how you interacted with the website. This information may be used to monitor or improve website performance but it will not be used to deliver any sort of advertising. By continuing to browse the site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

Information we receive from other sources

We may receive information about you from third parties such as online travel agents or booking engines and payment processors. When that data is collected from you, you should be informed by those third parties at that stage that it may be shared with us and combined with data collected from multiple sources.

Information we share with third party providers

We may share your personally identifiable information with service providers including:

- Payment processors for secure credit card payment transactions.
- Hosting services.
- Email service providers to send emails pertaining to your booking. Such providers may send emails of a marketing nature if you have agreed to receive such newsletters.
- Legal authorities when we believe in good faith that we are lawfully authorised or required to do so or when necessary to do so to protect the rights and safety of our business from fraudulent, abusive, inappropriate or unlawful use of our services.
- In connection with, or during negotiations of sale of Church House Farm or in any situation where personally identifiable information may be disclosed or transferred as one of the business assets of Church House Farm

How we protect your information

We take reasonable and appropriate measures to protect personal information loss, misuse and unauthorised access, disclosure, alteration and destruction. Your personal information is contained behind secured networks and all credit card information you supply is encrypted.

Access to personally identifiable information
